**ELLENBURG ART GALLERY**

The Ellenburg Art Gallery, located on the main level of the Homewood Public Library, features work by local and regional artists such as Robin Nance Richard. Artist guilds such as the Embroiderer's Guild of America, Birmingham Needlehearts Chapter, and educational exhibits by groups such as the Birmingham Paleontological Society are also featured.

In September, the Ellenburg Art Gallery will feature an exhibit by The Urban Studio (more formally known as The Auburn Center for Architecture and Urban Studies) showcasing works by students and faculty of the nationally renowned Auburn University School of Architecture. The Urban

Studio, under the guidance of Professor Cheryl Morgan, is an outreach venue for Auburn's School of Architecture where fourth year and thesis students pursue design, professional practice and engage in community projects, which have included work in Homewood's Rosedale neighborhood.
