Introduction to MS Excel

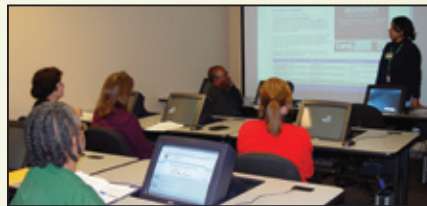
Learn about spreadsheets and how to use them to compute financial data and create documents.
