- **New Year Resolution Contest** - Dec. 28-Jan. 28. Add your New Year Resolution to our wall and you might win a new book to start your year off right.

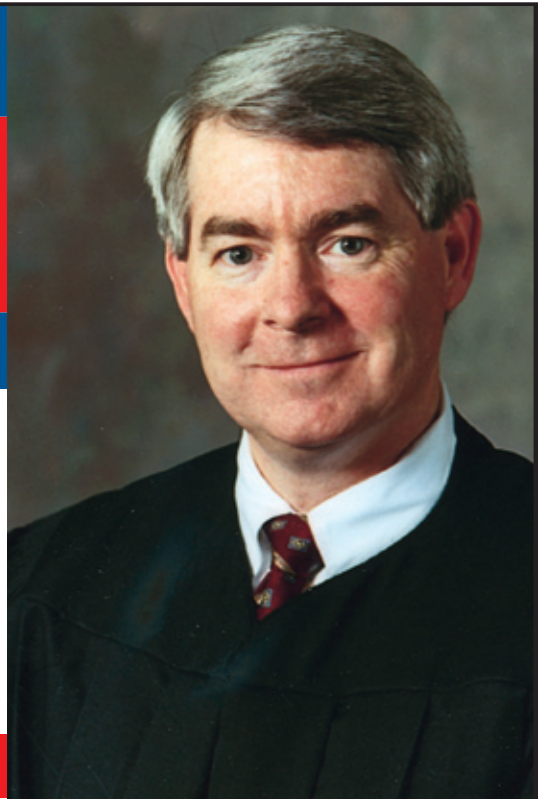
